**S EPARATED: FAMILIES AT THE BORDER**

Between April and June 2018, 2654 children were separated from their parents due to a new federal "zero-tolerance" policy implemented on the southern US border. As of August 24, 528 of those children have not been reunited with their parents, and 343 of them have a parent who has already been deported from the country. For these children, the trauma is still ongoing. Join us today from 5 pm - 7 pm in the Fellowship Hall for a panel conversation on what led us to this point, what is currently happening, and how we can help.
